sunrise is the one most charged. Christmas reminds us of the birth of Christ in every heart, whereas Easter gives us the realization of the Christ victory over every obstacle surrounding the lower consciousness.

At all the mystic festivals the Perfected Beings who love humanity and the Angels who administer to it are colorfully, musically, and gloriously near. Sensing and seeing them causes us to feel, *What is man, that Thou art mindful of him? And the son of man, that Thou visitest him?* Ps 8:4.

Easter has a great meaning for us individually. It indicates the recognition and acceptance of the Christ within us. The Indwelling Christ has control over all things with which we are concerned. This festival illustrates the initiation of that Man who decides to live from his highest consciousness, though it means the crucifixion of all unworthy tendencies and beliefs.
