Our meditation keynote for tonight is on the trilogy upon which our star rests:

Spiritual Completeness - Mental Alertness - Physical Soundness





Our Star Points:

God's Immediacy

Wisdom's Inclusiveness - Loves Kindness

Faith's Fertility - Accurancy's Simplicity

Reverences Wholeness - Humility's Recreation

The Great Ones teach—

Swiftly move time's currents. Into that swiftness we project these thoughts:

Think of the bright, seven-pointed star of daily considerations as resting within a trilogy of overflowing powers, the first of which is PHYSICAL SOUNDNESS, the second of which is MENTAL ALERTNESS, and the third of which is SPIRITUAL COMPLETENESS.

Observe that the base points of the bright star of this work's faith rest upon *reverence* and *humility*, while the uppermost point signifies the immediacy of God

Supreme. Every day you are to recollect these ten points which form the foundation of your inter-related efforts.

An excellent occasion for the recital of the trilogy and its star is that of high noon. Your daily occupations should find you recalling frequently the special star-point and trilogy emanation which the moment requires or suggests. With increased balanced endeavor you should become not only able participants of these forces, but likewise joyful benefactors of their purposeful emanations.

Were you to excel with fullest proficiency in these specialized arts, Mastership would be imminent. For that reason, the ten branches of this ministry's tree of purpose requires continual recollection and reflection.

Consider the trilogy that foundation which supports the luminous star of your spiritual objectives with ever-expanding creativeness.
