



Triumph Extraordinary

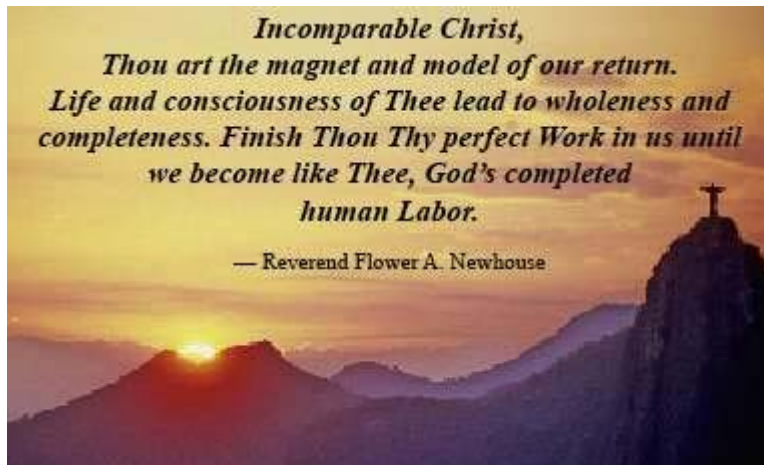

Easter reveals to us the greatest achievement that man may attain. Even those who are not Christians honor the name of the Christ and know that in His name great potencies of power flow forth to baptize, to quicken, to renew, to enlighten and to redeem the outer and the inner man. It is impossible to ponder on the feat of Christ on Easter morn without drawing closer to Him. Meditate for five minutes upon the Lord Christ alone and see what happens. When you take up your outer work again you have brought back with you through the channelship of the spirit indwelling His remarkable power.

Our Lord Christ knew that He was a Hierarch and that He had a tremendous service to perform. Our Lord's purpose in incarnating on earth was not only to finish His own degrees of Lordhood; it was to sound forth an impulse that would reach every sensitive person, everyone who is wide awake. This impulse as it touched us gave us spiritual awakening, enabled us to live without this tremendous self-righteous exertion, this terrible stress some people know because they are less than perfect. That was all overcome and washed away when we found our Lord in the fullest sense, both visibly and invisibly.
