The Conclusion of Northwest Lecture Tours with Flower, which began in May 1965

There were three tours and I'm no longer certain of the years, nor the chronological dates of events. However, I recall that on the first tour we were in Seattle on Flower's birthday, May 10, 1965. Ralph and Myrtle Koen, and George Noller joined us there.

We thought it might be special to treat Flower to her birthday dinner in the revolving restaurant atop the Space Needle. As most of you know, Flower, when it was possible, enjoyed solitude on her special day—for reflection, meditating and perhaps a walk in nature—so she declined the Space Needle experience. Instead we all had a delicious dinner in the more subdued but elegant atmosphere of our hotel dining room.

Flower's talk was scheduled for the evening of May 11th. The following morning we would need to leave very early in order to reach San Francisco for the promised second talk there May 12th.

While Flower prepared for her talk, I took "Blessing," the station wagon, to a nearby service station for gas and checking. In 1965 there were attendants who washed the windshield, checked oil, radiator, and tires as the tank was being filled. After all of this was finished, the attendant told me to have the right rear tire checked whenever we stopped for gas. There was no immediate problem but it would need watching. I didn't think Flower needed

to be bothered with this; I would just do as advised.

We left Seattle at 3:00 a.m. As soon as we were on the freeway, Flower began her prayer and meditation. When she finished, her first words were, “Faye dear, we must be aware of the right rear tire. It doesn’t respond to my prayer.” As you can imagine, goose bumps fluttered all through my being. I told Flower about the station attendant telling me the same thing and asked her what kind of message or insight she had received. She explained that she asks for and envisions Christ’s protective White Light enfolding every part of familiar and important functions of the vehicle. If there’s a problem the area or part remains a gray color—Light did not enfold that tire. Needless to say, we both kept it in our prayers. That was probably the first time I realized how thorough Flower was in her prayer work.

How can anyone not be filled with awe, respect, love and gratitude for such a selfless soul as Flower!

(We did make it to San Francisco in time for her lecture; no problem with the tire, and even time for Flower to rest before her talk. The tire was replaced after arriving back at Questhaven.)
